Programming Meeting
3 January 2007

- 1. The Minutes from last meeting 4 October 2006 were reviewed. Dot motioned to accept the minutes without revision. Melinda Seconded. Motion Carried.
- 2. Program Coordinator's Report:
 - a. Bob Skold noted new shows of the Folkways Collection on Saturdays from 9-10PM and a Special Collections show that Bob hosts on Mondays from 7-8PM and rebroadcast in an early morning slot on Wednesday.
 - b. Discussion was continued regarding Bob's letter to the Hosts about a variety of issues from the proper cancellation protocol to proper station IDs and timely dues payment. Also there is some problem with hosts adjusting the heat in the studio; they should not do this. Bob will try to get this letter written by the next Programming Committee Meeting
 - c. Melinda announced that she will temporarily suspend her show, The Mews, but that already there is a substitute program in that slot, Free Speech Radio News.

- 3. Discussion followed about the research requested from Charlene Peavey about host attendance at their scheduled times. There was concern that hosts weren't doing their shows but Charlene's investigation showed that most hosts were signing the logs at their scheduled times.

Discussion about regular host meetings: Melinda will continue her discussions with Rick Cowan of the Board of Directors about regular monthly or quarterly host gatherings though it seemed apparent to her that Friday Art Walk was not an acceptable time for these meetings. Melinda will pass a decision for host gathering date on to Bob Skold for inclusion in his monthly host leter.
- 8. Discussion about a weekly page of PSA from Dot to either website or email list for non-live hosts to read for their weekly recorded shows. We discussed the possibility of having a web-based collection of current recorded PSA which producers could use in the production of their shows. Further discussion is required on this topic.
