



Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting

Wednesday, 8 December 2010

33 Bridge Street Bellows Falls

1. Call To Order: 7:07pm

2. Meeting Minutes 11/20/2010: Don motioned and Maya seconded the motion to accept the minutes without amendment. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Financial Report [see attached]: Bob moves, Bill Holtz seconds motion to accept the Financial Report. Motion passes unanimously.

4. New Directors: Bob moves, Dickie seconds the motion that we appointed both John Michael Maciejewski and Kristen Fehrenbach to the Board of Directors. The motion passes unanimously with voting rights beginning at this moment.

5. Old Business:

a. Programming:

i. *New shows?* There are no new shows this month.

ii. *Cancelled / Postponed / Rescheduled shows*

1. Random Fandom is still on hiatus until automation is set up for them.

2. Craig Divis has stopped doing The Eclectic Envoy.

b. Training: Timothy Weatherford is seeking training.

c. Fall/Winter Fundraising:

i. **Radioke Progress:** After 4 of the 5 Radioke events, a report of the finances of Radioke to date was presented showing a profit already. General agreement about trademarking "Radioke" was expressed with Bob recommending a floor of \$800 in profit would signal the need to trademark. A budget expense of \$275 for this trademark was approved by consensus of the Board. Discussion was had about ways to increase the bar efficiency. *Added: John Michael noted later in the meeting [placed here for convenience] that he has been offered a Sam Adams sponsorship for the next series of Radio - most likely starting in March - in which the liquor distributor will donate \$1000 in cash if Sam Adams is the promoted beer at the event. The Board will take this under advisement while planning the next series.

- ii. **Silent Auction:** A report was presented detailing the earnings our 11/19 Silent Auction which netted approximately \$3800.00. [report attached.] Recommendations for the next auction are a) make it last longer and b) put more items on eBay.
- iii. **Mardi Gras:** General discussion of Mardi Gras event. The board concurred that since we've added the Buckwheat Zydeco Concert to our February schedule, there is no need to the traditional Mardi Gras dinner and dance. Discussion shifted to how to integrate past experiences with the Buckwheat Zydeco concert and there was some unresolved interest in servicing food in the Women's Club during the concert. Maya recommended serving Pig's feet. Further discussion appears later in these notes.
- d. **Membership Drive:** There was general discussion of the winter Membership Drive showing only 75 renewals so far. A list was circulated of members not yet renewed which contained many of our hosts and board members. Gary noted he soon would be sending a second renewal notice to all members with a second copy of the renewal form and various news.
- e. **Audio Documentary Contest:** Deadline for submission is Dec 30. If judging is required, Board will be drafted into service. A PSA will be put on the air announcing the end of the contest.
- f. **PTFP Grant:** A general briefing was given on the progress towards submission of the PTFP Grant application. Slow progress. New good info from the engineer, Rob Robbins. PTFP still not funded by Congress for this year's awards.
- g. **Bylaws Amendment:** After discussion of the need for WOOL to adopt a non-sectarian station posture, Bob motioned and Dickie seconded the motion that:
 - “We hold a Special Meeting of the Members to amend our bylaws in order to
 - 1. include “non-sectarian” language in the “Purpose” and in the non-discrimination clause.
 - 2. To increase the number of Directors’ seats on the Board to thirteen.
 - 3. Clarify any other outstanding bylaws issues that might be determined problematic at the meeting.”

The motion passed unanimously. Gary will send the notice to the membership.

6. New Business:

- a. **Turntables:** Based on Dickie's research it was decided that we will purchase an Audio Technica PL120 turntable and so end the century old debate about turntables at WOOL. Gary will order it and Dickie will install it in a professional manner.
- b. **Buckwheat Zydeco:** After discussion with the Directors in email and otherwise, an offer will go in to Buckwheat's agent this week for February 10, 2010. Gary met with the Opera House and with Buckwheat's agent. The offer will be for \$2500. Gary will inform the Board of any progress.
- c. **Facebook:** A general discussion was had about the impact of Facebook on our membership and the public perception of the station.
- d. **WOOL Blogs & Community Calendar:** Gary presented information about the upcoming deployment of a new Community Calendar component of the website built by Mark Piepkorn that will dovetail with the new Host Blog soon to be available online. Projected deployment is January 2011. There was discussion about the proper formatting of PSAs in the PSA binder and

some improvements were suggested to Kristen. [The precise suggestions were not captured by the note-taker.]

7. Other Business?

- a. Systems Crash:** There was a general briefing about the current crisis in technology: The station was off the air for five days leading up to this meeting. The main automation computer blew its hard drive and took with it all info stored there. Tony found backups. Gary is purchasing a new version of Station Playlist [budget \$150]. Art Coates has rebuilt a computer donated by Charlie Brady to serve as the new Automation Computer.. Projected date back on the air: Thursday, Dec 9th. The station log is notated. Costs for this repair will be approximately \$300.00.
 - b. New UPS Purchase:** Our old uninterruptible power supply has become defective and it is recommended that a new one be purchased and installed ASAP. Bob moved, Justin seconded the motion that we purchase the product recommended by Tony Elliott. Motion passed with one person voting no.
 - c. New EAS Machine:** Gary informed the Board that soon we will need to purchase a new Emergency Alert System as will be required by the FCC. This may run us as much as \$3000 and we should be prepared for the expense. The deadline is September 2011.
 - d. Gary Will Be Away In March:** Gary will be away in from February 15 - March 15 and will not be able to attend a board meeting in the first two weeks of March.
 - e. Next Meeting:** The second Wednesday in January the 12th. This is the next scheduled meeting date. Justin noted he cannot attend. Dickie moves that he bring beer and that Don Malcolm bring goldfish to the next meeting. No vote was taken.
- 8. Motion To Adjourn:** Dot moved, Maya seconded that we adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting was adjourned at 8:44pm.
